The group was recognized for their continued support of the *Cole Kids' Clean up Stockwell* program. Mike Pinto, principal of Cole, and Kris Ziller, chair of KSB, accepted the award at a ceremony at SIA. The group accepted a beautiful crystal trophy and a check for \$250 to use in their clean up and beautification efforts.

Great American Cleanup is a Success!

The Great American Cleanup National Campaign ended at the end of May and KSB had a banner campaign. Thanks to all of you who helped with all the different projects to help our community retain its' curb appeal. The preliminary numbers are staggering:

Bags of Garbage Collected: 100

Miles of Road Cleaned: 15

Tires Collected: 183

Flowers Planted: approximately 700

Bulky Trash Collected

Volunteers: 224

Volunteer Hours: 652

Cost Savings: \$8,224.17

A rain garden and butterfly garden were added to the Cole Outdoor Education Center along with an additional flower box on the baseball diamond in Stockwell. Benches, picnic tables, and a grill and horseshoe pit were added to the SUMC grove. This was an eagle project for David Berg.

There were several thousands of dollars in "in-kind" donations and grants contributed to this project too!
